

SOREF JCC MAKING A COMMUNITY IMPACT

Services are available to all Broward residents regardless of race, religion, age, gender, or ethnicity.

WECARE FOOD PANTRY – provides free non-perishable food and supplemental fruits/vegetables to Broward County residents in need

Key Impact Metrics:

- **Scale of Service:** The pantry benefits over **11,000 individuals annually**.
- **Children Under 18 and Seniors Served:** Roughly **50% of all recipients are considered most vulnerable** including children under 18 or seniors.
- **Diverse Population Served:** 43% Black, 23% Latino, 28% White, and 6% primarily Haitian.
- **Volume of Food:** Approximately **4,200 bags of free groceries** are distributed each year to neighbors in need at an approximate **total retail value of \$294,000**.
- **Recipient Screening:** Social case workers from **over 30 Broward County nonprofit organizations** screen and refer clients to the WECARE Food Pantry

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS – provide high-quality programs in safe, supervised environments that foster a child's academic, physical, and social development while providing essential child care for working families.

Key Impact Metrics:

- **Scale of Service:** Approximately 1,100 youth, ages 3 Months – 14 Years Old
- **Scope of Service:** 5 Afterschool Programs, 4 Summer Camp Programs, 2 Preschools
- **Diverse Population Served:** 25% Latino, 35% Black, 40% White
- **Children Served from Economically Disadvantaged Neighborhoods:** 37%
- **Children's Scholarships Provided:** \$250,000 projected for 2026
- **Services Provided:** Homework assistance, social & emotional learning, academics, sports, enrichments, swim lessons with certified lifeguards in JCC pool, field trips, cultural shows
